HISTORY OF SWEDISH DESIGN

Swedish design culture has flourished for over a century. In the late 1800s, Swedes distinguished themselves in the design business as they emphasised simplicity, form and light colours. Since the 1940's, Swedish designers have produced textiles, glass, ceramics, furniture and flatware that seamlessly merge craftsmanship and industry.

After the 1940s, an emphasis on economy, both in aesthetics and cost, was a natural extension of the country's post-war social ideals. Functionality and simplicity proved to be lasting principles of 20th century design. Swedish products often are multifunctional, but all are beautiful, creative and reflective of an expansive imagination. This is why the cutting-edge design of "Swedish classics" is so highly sought after by discriminating clientele.
